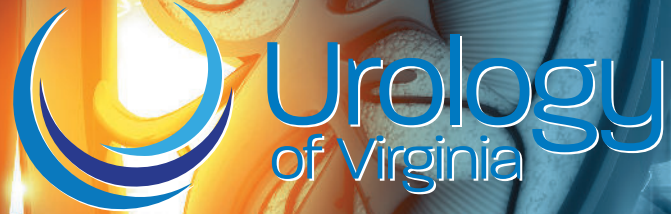

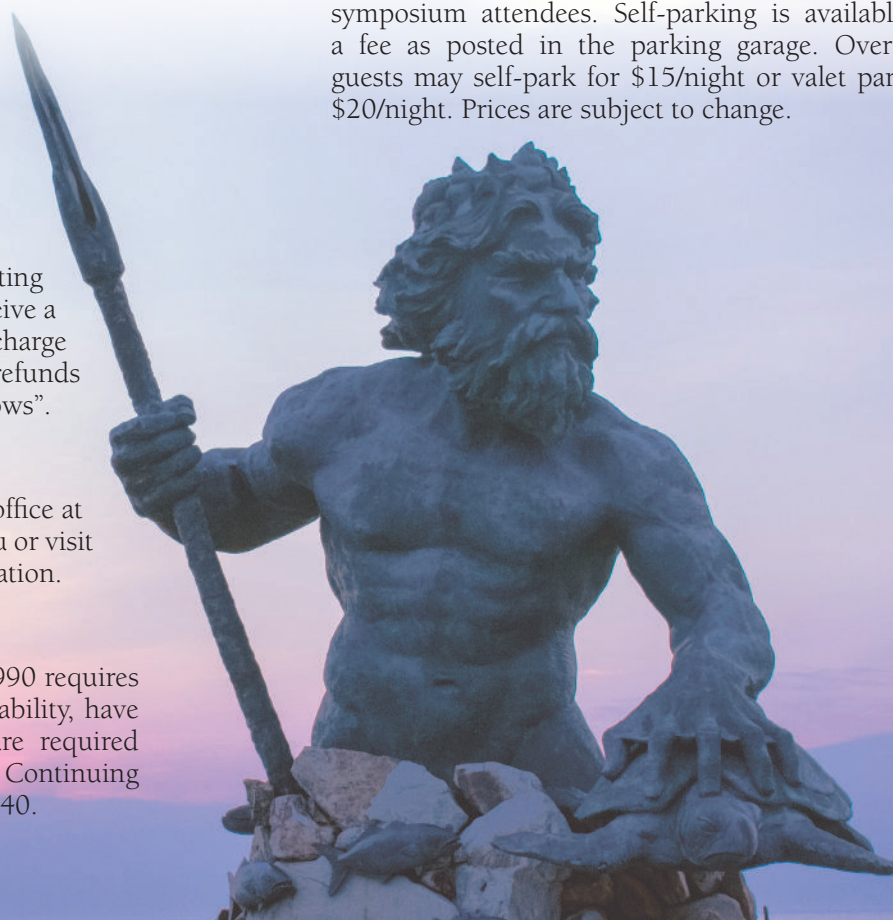
HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS
